Job Location:

- Various locations throughout central New Jersey

Job Description and Responsibilities:

- Teach students how to become lifeguards (or recertify current lifeguards) following the American Red Cross lifeguarding course plan
- Instructor would potentially be responsible for the following (see “Pay Rate” below for further details):
 - Securing the pool/classroom time (we can do this for you for a reduced pay rate)
 - Filling the classes with students (we can do this for you for a reduced pay rate)
 - Must have a minimum of 5 students in order to run course
 - Choosing the dates/times/locations that you want to run the courses
 - Running the courses exactly to the Red Cross requirements

Job Benefits:

- All materials will be provided by CJPM (manikins, gloves, masks, books, tests, DVDs, backboards, buoys, etc)
- You will be covered under our general and professional liability insurance, so you are protected from any mistakes
- All course registration and signup will be run for you through our website

Dates of employment:

- April 1, 2015 - September 7, 2015
- Actual days and hours of work would vary weekly
- Most work would be in May and June on weekends

Prerequisites:

- Must be certified in American Red Cross Lifeguard Instructor (we will pay for your certification)
- Must be certified in American Red Cross Lifeguarding, First Aid and CPR/AED
- Must have at least 3 years of lifeguarding experience

Pay Rate:

- \$20 per hour for courses scheduled and filled by CJPM (8 or fewer students)
- \$25 per hour for courses scheduled and filled by CJPM (9 or more students)
- \$30 per hour for courses scheduled and filled by you (8 or fewer students)
- \$35 per hour for courses scheduled and filled by you (9 or more students)
